



Media & IT Block

Community Radio Raabta 90.8 MHz

Ultra Modern T.V studio has been established to meet the growing needs of the students to undertake multi-camera production. The studio is equipped with the latest digital cameras with teleprompter (for news reading exercises), online editing, cool & hot lighting set-up, Multi Channel Audio Console and studio talk back system. Latest video editing system FCP has been set-up to offer professional and purposeful training to the students and the department has acquired the latest digital cameras Sony Alfa 7, Nikon & Canon for both studio production and outdoor recording; digital cameras for still photography. Jalandhar's first campus Community Radio Raabta 90.8 MHz has been setup under the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India.

Libraray

A three storeyed whisper quiet library is equipped with open shelf system. The college has rich treasure of well-stocked library that has more than 73000 collections, 6000 journals 799500 e-books through E-ShodhSindhu (N-LIST Programme) and the library provides 24 hour accessibility. Each floor is systematically arranged with books and has separate reading places for UG & PG students. The college library is totally equipped with computerized cataloguing, classification, circulation, transaction, provision of Internet, multimedia, CD-based services, book alert services, periodical alert service, audio-video sections, resource material cell etc. In its peaceful and serene atmosphere, the students can widen their intellectual horizon by browsing books, journals, reference books etc. Web OPAC- Library users can search required books from college library data with 24x7 accessibility.

College Hostels: From home to home Jagan Nath Mittal Boys' Hostel

The college boys' hostel is in the premises of the college and consists of a magnificent building with intake capacity of 80 students. New building is equipped with modern scientific amenities. It has hygienic co-operative mess, common room with latest amenities viz indoor games, ultra modern dining hall, RO, Air cooled & AC Rooms with generator facility. It is run on co-operative basis. The food served to the students is nutritious, purely vegetarian and of excellent quality. Personal attention and parental care is given to students by the Principal and the staff with frequent visits to the hostel. The hostel is a safe haven for boarders as it provides a healthy, congenial and homely atmosphere.

Girls' Hostel

On persistent demand of the girl students joining the college from other states such as Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan, J & K as well as other regions of Punjab, girls hostel is fully functional and is equipped with modern amenities. The girls' hostel is built with ultra modern building with all the modern facilities viz Air Cooled & AC Rooms with generator facilities with intake capacity of 96 students.

KNOW THE RULES

Limited Seats: Students can join these courses within the prescribed dates of admission. There are limited seats in all these courses and the admission will stop as soon as the required number of seats in a particular course are filled. **Eligibility Criteria:**

· For UG Classes:

The student who has passed their lower examinations from other Board sexcept PSEB must submit migration certificate in original along with requisite fee as decided by GNDU, Asr. in the college office.

For PG Classes:

The student who has passed their lower examinations from other Universities except GNDU must submit migration certificate in original along with requisite fee as decided by GNDU, Asr. in the college office.

Late Admission: The Principal is authorized to permit the late admission or recommend admission to Vice Chancellor but normally this will be extended only in rare cases subject to the availability of seats. In case of students whose University or Board result is declared late, no late fee will be charged if they apply for admission within ten days of declaration of the result. The Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to any candidate without assigning any reason. The Principal can cancel the admission of any student who has been admitted to the College without assigning any reason whatsoever.

Provisional Admission: Those students who have appeared in final exams of the lower classes and their results are not yet declared may also apply for admission in higher classes, provisionally with a payment of Rs. 5000/-, subject to the eligibility by GNDU Asr. A student admitted provisionally has to get admission by submitting the copy of DMC of lower exams and depositing the 1st installment of course fee within 5 days of declaration of result for issue of University Registration Number failing which, the admission of the student in the College shall stand cancelled automatically although he/she might have paid the fee. If a student fails to fulfill eligibility conditions, full amount of registration fee paid will be refunded. The amount shall not be refunded if admission is offered by the college but refused by the student.

• Admission to the College is made provisionally at the sole risk and responsibility of a student and its subject to subsequent approval of GNDU. If approval to the admission is withheld by the competent authority (for the reason that the student concerned has failed to provide the required documents in time/has hidden some information/given false information/is not eligible to join the class otherwise), the entire responsibility in such a case will lie with the student himself/herself. He/she will not be entitled to any refund whatsoever from the college.



Admission Process & Document Checklist

- The application for admission is to be made on the prescribed printed admission form available from the college Library/ Admission Cell along with the Prospectus. It should be accompanied by:
- A certificate from father/mother/guardian of the applicant to the effect that he/she is joining the college with his/her permission.
- Two passport size photograph.
- A certificate of good moral character from the Head of the institution last attended.
- Original certificates, mark sheets, a photocopy of attested character certificate, attested photocopies of the lower examination passed.
- Scheduled Caste/Tribe/Backward Class students must attach the certificate from the competent authority.
- Outstanding sports persons, speakers, singers & artists must submit supporting certificates/testimonials.
- For UG Course: The student who has passed their lower examinations from other Boards except PSEB must submit migration certificate in original along with requisite fee as decided by GNDU, Asr. in the college office.
- For PG Classes: The student who has passed their lower examinations from other Universities except GNDU must submit migration certificate in original along with requisite fee as decided by GNDU, Asr. in the college office.
- The student is required to appear personally for admission.

Rules for Change of Subject/Faculty

- Students of TDC Sem.-I may apply for change of subjects in the same faculty/group within 15 days from the commencement of teaching on payment of fee of Rs. 500/- each subject. They may be allowed to change the group/faculty if they fulfill other requirements laid down by the college/university.
- Application for change of faculty may be made on the prescribed form available in the Office with fee of Rs.1000/- within 15 days from the commencement of teaching course. Such application form should also be signed by the HoDs/ parents/ guardians of the applicant. The change, if allowed, will be at student's own risk.
- In case of change of subject from Science group to Arts group, Science fee paid in the previous course will not be refunded.
- Students changing from Arts to Science group will have to pay science fee for full session.
- Change of subject will be granted at the student's own risk. No benefit of the lectures attended in the previous subject can be given for the new subject.
- Change of subject will be permitted only once.
- No application will be entertained after the last date of change of subject i.e. 10 days after the last date of commencement of classes.

Refusal of Admission

The Principal has full power to refuse admission to an applicant without assigning any reason.

Note: While every care is taken to screen eligibility of the candidate before admission is granted, the responsibility for ensuring the eligibility lies on the student.

Girl students are eligible for admission in all classes/courses in all streams.

Bachelor of Arts (BA) (Three year degree course under semester system)

Eligibility: A student who has passed +2 of PSEB/CBSE or other equivalent examination, is eligible to join BA Sem I.

Subject combinations for BA Sem I

A student will take up English (Compulsory) and Punjabi (Compulsory)/Basic Punjabi and three Subjects out of the following combinations: Mathematics / Psychology / History / Elective-English / Punjabi/Hindi/Sanskrit (Sanskrit Elective with Hindi Elective is allowed), Geography, Journalism & Mass Communication, Economics, Political Science, Physical Education/Computer Science Note: (i) Subjects once taken in BA Sem I can not be changed. (ii) Students are advised to choose one or two job oriented practical subjects out of three elective subjects. Student may get more information from Admission Counseling Cell.

RAGGING: PROHIBITION, PREVENTION AND PUNISHMENT

The University Grants Commission vide its letter no F.1-16/2007 (CPP-II) dated June 17, 2009 has reiterated the ban on ragging of students in Institutions of Higher Learning. The students are therefore directed to strictly desist from any kind of ragging.

PUNISHMENT FOR PARTICIPATION IN/OR ABETMENT OF RAGGING:

1. Cancellation of admission. 2. Suspension from attending classes. 3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits. 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process. 5. Withholding results. 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc. 7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel. 8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period. 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution. 10. Fine up to Rs. 25,000/-

AFFIDAVIT BY STUDENTS AND PARENTS:

Each student and his/her parents/ guardian shall have to furnish an online affidavit along with the application form to the effect that they will not participate in or abet the act of ragging and that, if found guilty, shall be liable for punishment under the penal law of India.
